

A regular meeting of the Planning Commission was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street, on Monday, June 4, 2018, at 7:00 p.m.

Chair Vanek called the meeting to order. Present were Chair Vanek and Commissioners Malewski, Parsons, Wegner, Baker, Skinner, Herrera and Letarte. Commissioner DeGrow was absent and excused.

Also in attendance at the meeting was Building Official LeRoy Hummel and City Manager Aaron Desentz.

Commissioner Malewski moved the Planning Commission approve the Agenda as printed; seconded by Commissioner Letarte, passed unanimously.

Commissioner Malewski moved that the March 5, 2018, Minutes be approved as printed; seconded by Commissioner Baker, passed unanimously.

Darren Tanner, 509 S. Main Street, appeared before the Commission regarding the Lot Split request for property that he owns at 702 Plain Street and what his plans are for the property.

Commissioner Wegner moved that the Planning Commission approve the Lot Split request for property located at 702 Plain Street; seconded by Commissioner Letarte, passed unanimously.

Commissioner Baker reported to the Planning Commission the most recent Zoning Board of Appeals meetings that had been held.

Building Official Hummel reported to the Commission that there are new homes being built; gave a brief update on the Mag Plant; and gave an update on the Forsberg property and what they are planning for the old location of the Hickory Haven Trailer Park.

City Manager Desentz reported to the Commission that work will begin on getting a new Master Plan together and will need their involvement in this process.
