

A Worksession of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street, on Monday, November 5, 2018, at 5:00 p.m.

Present were Mayor Malewski and Councilpersons Burke, Harri, Wichman and Colestock. None were absent.

Administrative Staff Present were City Manager Aaron Desentz, Fire Chief Roger McNutt, City Treasurer Marrie Jo Carr and Police Chief Larry Weeks.

New Business Topics of Discussion were:

This item will appear on the November 19th Agenda for Council consideration.

City Manager Desentz reviewed th PA 202 Action Plan. Councilman Wichman moved that the Council proceed with the PA 202 Action Plan as presented; seconded by Councilwoman Colestock, passed unanimously. City Manager Desentz stated that he will give updates to Council as they happen. Council thanked City Manager Desentz for the review.

City Manager Desentz reviewed with Council the Master Plan quotes that had been received. Councilwoman Colestock moved Council approve the proposal from Beckett and Reader; seconded by Councilman Burke, passed unanimously. City Manager Desentz stated that he will keep Council informed on the progress.

Police Chief Weeks introduced the Lien Access Proposal. Council asked questions regarding the proposal. Council instructed Chief Weeks to proceed with the Lien Access Proposal as presented.

Police Chief Weeks reviewed the proposal for the Data Exchange Software. After a lengthy discussion, Chief Weeks will talk with the Prosecutor and come back to Council with more information.
