City Council Special Meeting

A special meeting of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street, on Tuesday, May 7, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.

Mayor Malewski called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Malewski and Councilpersons Harri, Colestock, Burke and Wichman.

Councilman Harri moved to approve the agenda; seconded by Councilwoman Colestock, passed unanimously.

New Business:

City Manger Desentz requested a closed session to review his annual performance evaluation. Councilwoman Colestock moved Council go into closed session for City Manager Desentz's personnel evaluation; seconded by Councilman Burke, passed unanimously by roll call vote. Council went into closed session at 5:04 p.m.
