

**September 23, 2019
City Council Meeting**

A regular meeting of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street, on September 23, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Malewski called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

Present were Mayor Malewski and Councilpersons Wichman, Burke, Colestock, and Harri.

The invocation was given by Pastor Marty DeBow of First United Methodist Church.

Harri moved, Colestock seconded, PASSED, to approve the amended agenda removing New Business a. Special Event Application Approval- ERHS Homecoming Parade as it was approved at the September 23rd Worksession.

Harri moved, Burke seconded, PASSED, to approve the September 9th worksession minutes and the September 9th Council meeting minutes.

Burke moved, Wichman seconded, PASSED to approve the disbursements of \$297,475.18.
