A regular meeting of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street, on June 22, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Malewski called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

Mayor Malewski led the invocation with a recitation of the Lord's Prayer.

Colestock moved, Steele seconded, PASSED, to approve the agenda.

Public Comments:

County Commissioner Barb Rogers reported that Eaton County has not begun work on the budget because that State has not reported revenues. She advised that she attended a Recycling Committee meeting. She reported that a parks millage is not planned for the 2020 election cycle.

Fire Chief McNutt reported that have had a few fires in the City recently.

City Attorney Harkness reported that he has hired another attorney. He advised that he will be scheduling a closed session in the near future.

Clerk Boomer reported that she will be testing some of the election equipment this week and mailing absent voter ballots out on Thursday to voters who had already applied for a ballot.

City Manager Desentz provided an update on the CDBG project. There have been some issues with EGLE. He reviewed the grant process moving forward.

Councilwoman Politza requested a review of the State Street detour. She commented on theft problems at the cemetery.

Mayor Malewski reported that the river clean-up went well. They removed about 450-500 pounds of trash from the river. He advised that he was strong willed tonight and voted with his convictions.
