

A worksession of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street, on Monday, October 15, 2012, at 5:00 p.m.

Present were Mayor Platte and Councilpersons Brown, Greenhoe, Harri and Norris. None were absent.

Administrative Staff Present was City Manager Jon Stoppels, DPW/WWTP Director Todd Nichols, Utility Director Scott Poyer and City Clerk Kristy Reinecke.

Purpose of the meeting was a worksession. Notice of the meeting was duly given.

**Old Business Topics of Discussion were:**

City Manager Stoppels reviewed with Council the bids that had been received for the Library Facade repairs. City Manager Stoppels stated that the wall has moved even more, so that it is imperative that the repairs are done before Winter. City Manager Stoppels stated that he, the DPW/WWTP Supervisor and the Utility Director, along with the City Engineers, will be working closely with the contractor to track the expenses on this project.

Councilman Norris moved that Council approve the bid from Laux Construction in the amount of \$88,900 for the repair work to the Library facade; seconded by Councilman Greenhoe, passed unanimously.

**New Business Topics of Discussion were:**

City Manager Stoppels stated that at the meeting tonight, the Council would be hearing three proposals from Engineers on the City's Utility Master Plan, and to come back at a later meeting to discuss the proposals and to select an Engineer. City Manager Stoppels stated that each firm would be giving a 45 minute presentation.

The firms that gave proposals were C2AE; Hubbell, Roth and Clark; and Prien & Newhof.
