Councilman Norris reviewed with Council the proposal from Clean Energy Coalition for the Area Wide Master Plan. Councilman Norris stated that the old Plan has expired, and that the cost is \$14,000, which will be split three ways with Hamlin and Eaton Rapids Township.
