Eaton County Treasurer Bob Robinson and County Commissioner Roger Harris were present at the meeting to hear the City's concerns regarding the Road Millage Disbursements. After a lengthy discussion, County Treasurer Robinson and County Commissioner Harris stated that they will continue to look at the disbursement language and report back to Council.

City Clerk Reinecke reviewed with Council the MDOT Safe Routes to School Funding Resolution that needs to be approved by Council to proceed with the project that is scheduled to start in June. This item will appear on the March 9th Agenda.
