

A regular meeting of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street on Monday, April 13, 2015. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Platte called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Platte and Councilpersons McGee and Burke. Councilpersons Brown and Harri were absent and excused.

The invocation was given by Councilman Burke.

The Agenda was approved as printed.

The March 23, 2015, Regular Minutes were approved as printed.

Councilman Burke moved that disbursements of \$1,167,241.28 be approved with the breakdown being General Fund Checks in the amount of \$271,312.37 - check numbers 63535 through 63616; Meter Deposit Refund Checks in the amount of \$654.93 - check numbers 101122 through 101132; and Wire Fund Transfers in the amount of \$895,273.98; seconded by Councilman McGee, passed unanimously.

Councilman McGee moved Council approve the Eaton Rapids Ministerial Associations request to use the Pocket Park adjacent to City Hall on Thursday, May 7th from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for the National Day of Prayer; seconded by Councilman Burke, passed unanimously.

Councilman Burke moved Council approve the bid from HTA Companies in the amount of \$1,600.00 per month for the 2015/2016 Street Sweeping work; seconded by Councilman McGee, passed unanimously.

Councilman Burke moved Council approve the Agreement with Parsons Brinckerhoff Michigan, Inc., for Task Order Number 6 at the Eaton Rapids Landfill; seconded by Councilman McGee, passed unanimously.

Councilman McGee moved Council approve Amendment No. 1 from C2AE for the Agreement for Professional services for the Safe Routes to School Sidewalk and ADA Ramp Improvements in the amount of \$6,250.00; seconded by Councilman Burke, passed unanimously.

Councilman McGee moved Council approve the Special Event Request from Scott Fraser for the Visually Impaired Kayak Program to be held on May 15th through the 18th at 114 Mill Street; seconded by Councilman Burke, passed unanimously.

Reuben Green, 630 Forest Street, appeared before Council regarding violations to the City's Ordinances and Zoning Code.

Councilman Burke reported on the following: thanked Mr. Fraser for the Kayak Event which is great for the Community; that the BPW Scrap for Scholarship Event is April

25th and 26th; and Congratulated Athletic Director Jeff Dassance on being named the Regional Athletic Director of the Year.

Councilman McGee reported on the following: that he went Geo Caching this weekend and there are many places around the City and it is a really cool and fun thing to do in the Community.

City Manager Stoppels reported on the following: that he had distributed an informational update today and if there were any questions to see him; that several statements made tonight by a citizen were inaccurate and incorrect and that enforcement has been started on several issues that were brought to the City's attention in the Fall and that progress is being made.

Mayor Platte reported on the following: congratulated the ERHS Wrestling Coach for being named the Coach of the Year.
