New Business Topics of Discussion were:

Utility Director Poyer reviewed with Council the proposal from GRP Engineering for the System Arc-Flash Study. Utility Director Poyer stated that the proposal would be a cost of \$9,800 for the Electric Study and \$5,200 for the Water Study. This item will appear on the July 27th Agenda.

Utility Director Poyer reviewed with Council the proposal from GRP Engineering for the 2015 System Appraisal. Utility Director Poyer stated that the proposal would be a cost of \$11,000 for the System Appraisal. This item will appear on the July 27th Agenda.

Utility Director Poyer reviewed with Council the proposals that he had received for the City's IT work. After a lengthy discussion it was decided that Council will look into this deeper and review at a future worksession.
