

A regular meeting of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street on Monday, September 28, 2015. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Platte called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Platte and Councilpersons Harri, McGee, Burke and Brown. None were absent.

The invocation was given by Pastor Mark Michalcewicz of the Grace Baptist Church.

The Agenda was approved as printed.

The September 14, 2015, Regular Minutes and the September 21, 2015, Worksession Minutes were approved as printed.

Councilman Burke moved that disbursements of \$433,862.14 be approved with the breakdown being General Fund Checks in the amount of \$141,672.38 - check numbers 64389 through 64444; and Wire Fund Transfers in the amount of \$292,189.76; seconded by Councilwoman Brown, passed unanimously.

There were no Public Comments.

Councilwoman Brown moved Council approve the Mayor's recommendation to reappoint Jan McRee, 123 N. East Street, to the Local Officers Compensation Commission for a five year term which will expire on October 1, 2020; seconded by Councilman Burke, passed unanimously.

City Clerk Reinecke introduced for First Reading Ordinance 2015-19, an Ordinance to Amend the Code of the City of Eaton Rapids by Amending Chapter 10, Forfeiture. This was for First Reading only, no Council action was required.

City Clerk Reinecke introduced for First Reading Ordinance 2015-20, an Ordinance to Amend the Code of the City of Eaton Rapids by Amending Chapter 11, Garbage and Trash. This was for First Reading only, no Council action was required.

Councilman Burke reported on the following: that he was looking forward to the Urban Air Event; and that he was looking forward to Homecoming and that there were lots of things happening in Eaton Rapids this Fall.

Councilman Harri reported on the following: that he was looking forward to the Urban Air Event and that there were 110 coaches that had registered for the Event and everyone should get out and enjoy the great weekend that is being planned.

Councilman McGee reported on the following: that he is excited about Urban Air; that Fall in Eaton Rapids is beautiful; that the flags downtown look great; that the corn husks look awesome and Eaton Rapids looks great this Fall.

Councilwoman Brown reported on the following: that a good time was being planned for the Urban Air Event and that the pictures that have been taken of past Urban Air Events are awesome; that the weather looks great for this weekend and hopefully there will be a big crowd downtown enjoying Fall in Eaton Rapids.

City Manager Stoppels reported on the following: that he had sent out an informational update to Council and would be happy to answer any questions; and that this is the 5th year that the City has hosted Urban Air and that the final preparations are underway.

Mayor Platte reported on the following: thanked John Nobach for donating the corn stalks to the City and the workers who put them up; that Urban Air is going to be great this year and now there is the addition of the 5K Casa Superhero race and hoped everyone who could would participate in this event.
