

A regular meeting of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street on Monday, August 8, 2016. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Platte called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Platte and Councilpersons Harri, Burke and Colestock. Councilman McGee was absent and excused.

The invocation was given by Pastor Marty Debow of First United Methodist church.

The Agenda was approved as printed.

The July 25, 2016, Regular Minutes and the August 1, 2016 Worksession Minutes were approved as printed.

Councilman Harri moved that disbursements of \$405,706.41 be approved with the breakdown being General Fund Checks in the amount of \$376,845.36 - check numbers 65863 through 65915; Meter Deposit Refund Checks in the amount of \$1,041.41 - check numbers 101329 through 101338; and Wire Fund Transfers in the amount of \$127,819.64; seconded by Councilman Harri, passed unanimously.

Councilwoman Colestock moved Council approve the Special Event Request from Michigan's GAR Memorial Hall and Museum to hold the Third Annual Civil War Day of Discovery Camp on Wednesday, August 17th at GAR Island Park beginning at 10:00 a.m.; seconded by Councilman Burke, passed unanimously.

Marty Vanek, 1211 S. Main Street, appeared before Council regarding the street paving project and on City Taxes.

Rod Schultz, 1303 Montgomery Street, appeared before Council regarding the Police Department.

City Manager Stoppels reported on the following: that the Outdoor Recreation Center is open and there have been lots of rentals; that the street projects are underway and the parking lot projects will begin this week; and that the first phase of the Island Wall Restoration project is 75% completed and that they are planning on a September/October ribbon cutting ceremony.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
