

A worksession of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street, on Monday, October 17, 2016, at 5:00 p.m.

Present were Mayor Platte and Councilpersons McGee, Colestock and Burke. Councilman Harri was absent and excused.

Administrative Staff Present was City Manager Jon Stoppels, Building Official LeRoy Hummel, City Treasurer Marrie Jo Carr, Library Director Anna Curtis, Quality of Life Director Troy Stowell and City Clerk Kristy Reinecke.

New Business Topics of Discussion were:

City Manager Stoppels reviewed with Council the bills that need to be approved for the Parking Lot and Road Improvements. Councilman Burke moved that a check be written to TCI in the Amount of \$735,466.52; seconded by Councilwoman Colestock, passed unanimously.

City Clerk Reinecke reviewed with Council the need for a Jacket Water Heater for the Generators. City Clerk Reinecke stated that the Generator Technician had received three bids and it was his recommendation to go with the quote from Hot Start at a cost of \$5,400.00. This item will appear on the October 24th Agenda for Council consideration.

City Manager Stoppels reviewed with Council the desire to lease to purchase a tractor from D&G Equipment. City Manager Stoppels stated that this vehicle would be used for line clearance in the Electric Department as well as grounds maintenance at the new Northwestern Park trail system. City Manager Stoppels stated that right now D&G is offering 0% financing, so this was a good time to proceed with the much needed purchase. Old Business Topics of Discussion were:

City Manager Stoppels reviewed with Council the proposed Yard Waste Facility language. Council reviewed the proposed language and added their thoughts and inputs to the proposal. City Manager Stoppels will continue working on the language and bring back to a future worksession for further Council review.

City Manager Stoppels reviewed with Council the proposed Agreement with Granger for recycling services in the City for citizens who already have Granger as their trash company. This item will appear on the October 24th Agenda for Council consideration.
