

A regular meeting of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street on Monday, February 27, 2017. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Platte called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Platte and Councilpersons McGee, Burke and Colestock. Councilman Harri was absent and excused.

The invocation was given by Pastor DeMott of the Nazarene Church.

The Agenda was approved as printed.

The February 13, 2017, Regular Minutes and the February 20, 2017, Worksession Minutes were approved as printed.

Councilman Burke moved that disbursements of \$1,182,937.34 be approved with the breakdown being General Fund Checks in the amount of \$880,611.07 - check numbers 66837 through 66892; and Wire Fund Transfers in the amount of \$302,326.27; seconded by Councilman McGee, passed unanimously.

Rod Schultz, 1303 Montgomery Street, appeared before Council regarding the Police Department; IT Issues; Dog Ordinance and leash laws; and invited Council to attend the Republican Party Meeting that is being held on Thursday.

Barbara Rogers, Eaton County Commissioner, appeared before Council and gave updates on the Crandall Lake Project; Tour of Eaton County Jail; Availability of 3 Year Dog Licenses; Capital Area Community Services; Homelessness Grant; Continuous Care Committee; and the New Senior Housing project that is happening in Charlotte.

Reuben Green, 630 Forest Street, appeared before Council regarding the Street Program.

Councilman McGee reported on the following: that he had read an old news article from the 1900's that was very interesting.
