

Building Official Hummel reviewed with Council the Hickory Haven Trailer Court issue. Building Official Hummel stated that this property has reverted back to the County because of delinquent taxes. Building Official Hummel stated that the City has several options on how they wish to proceed with the Trailer Park and will keep Council informed as the County Treasurer continues to work on the situation.
