

A regular meeting of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street on Monday, August 14, 2017. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Pro Tem Harri called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Pro Tem Harri and Councilpersons Burke, McGee and Colestock. Mayor Platte was absent and excused.
