

A Worksession of the City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street, on Tuesday, January 2, 2018, at 5:00 p.m.

Present were Mayor Malewski and Councilpersons Burke, Harri, Wichman and Colestock. None were absent.

Administrative Staff Present was City Treasurer Marri Jo Carr, Police Chief Larry Weeks, Fire Chief Roger McNutt, Building Official LeRoy Hummel, Quality of Life Director Troy Stowell, Library Director Anna Curtis and City Clerk Kristy Reinecke.

Library Director Curtis reported on the following: that she is still dealing with a heating and water issue at the Library.

New Business Topics of Discussion were:

Mayor Malewski reviewed with Council the Appointments and Changes that he would be recommending to Council at the January 8th Council Meeting for Council consideration. Council thanked Mayor Malewski for the review.

Old Business Topics of Discussion were:

Mayor Malewski asked City Clerk Reinecke if there was an update from the MML on the City Manager search. City Clerk Reinecke stated that she had received correspondence from Joyce Parker and that there were now 12 candidates. City Clerk Reinecke stated that Ms. Parker will be submitting a report to her on Friday and that she will be giving the information to Council. Council directed City Clerk Reinecke to relay to the MML that if there were only 20 applicants then it would be Council's desire to have the MML give the City their top 5 picks, but also allow the Council to review all applicants. City Clerk Reinecke stated that she would be passing this information on to Ms. Parker.

Informational Updates:

Mayor Malewski reviewed with Council that Channel 10 News had been in the City today regarding a heating and water issue at Edgewater Apartments. Building Official Hummel stated that he had talked with the complainant and would be following up tomorrow at the Apartment Complex. Building Official Hummel stated that he would keep Council informed on his findings and if this would be a landlord/tenant issue or a violation of the Building Code that would need the City to get involved.
