







RESIDENTIAL HVAC REBATES

EARN A \$150 REBATE

WHEN YOU UPGRADE YOUR HOME HEATING AND COOLING EQUIPMENT.

Residential electric customers of participating utilities¹ can now earn significant rebates when they upgrade their home's heating and cooling systems to more energy-efficient models, along with other HVAC-related upgrades. **The available HVAC incentives include:**

-  **\$150 rebate for upgrading a furnace** to an energy-efficient model that includes an Electronically Commutated Motor (ECM).
-  **\$15.00 rebate for purchasing an ENERGY STAR[®] qualified dehumidifier**, which uses 15 percent less energy than a standard unit to remove the same amount of moisture from your room.²
-  **\$15.00 rebate for purchasing an ENERGY STAR[®] qualified room air conditioner**, which can save at least 10 percent on your energy bill when compared to a conventional unit.²
-  **\$150 rebate for upgrading a central air conditioning unit** to one with a 16 seasonal energy efficiency rating (SEER), which can save up to 15 percent on the typical energy bill. SEER 15 units earn an incentive of \$125. SEER 14 units earn an incentive of \$75.

In addition to these rebates, residential customers are encouraged to combine these Energy Smart rebates with other state programs. When you combine the available incentives with up to \$200² in savings on the typical annual energy bill, upgrading your equipment could bring significant savings.

Rebates are first come, first served. To find out more and obtain an application:

1. Visit **mienergysmart.com** and select your city in the drop-down menu.
2. Locate the **Residential HVAC** application on your city's page and click to download it to your computer.
3. **Complete the application** once the installation of the furnace or central AC system is complete or shortly after purchasing the ENERGY STAR qualified equipment.
4. **Follow the instructions** on the application on ways to turn it in.
